Conditions can be attached to a planning consent to enhance the quality of development and/or to enable development to proceed where it would otherwise have been necessary to refuse permission.

Section 106 agreements are legal agreements made between developers and local planning authorities.

They can be used to release funding to deliver projects and are designed to compensate the local community for any impact caused by a development - for example, if open space is lost. They can also be used to help shape a development - for example, to ensure that a certain proportion of homes are reserved for people with a local connection.
